- SC015 Tuxedo
- SC055 Yella Bout It
- SC074 Hot Tamale

### Decorating Accessories

- RB144 #4 Soft Fan
- RB106 #6 Script Liner
- RB-110 10/0 Detail Liner

### Miscellaneous Accessories

- Sponge
- Water
- Pencil
- Pattern

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Begin with properly fired cone 04 bisque. Moisten a sponge and wipe bisque to remove any dust.
2. Using the Soft Fan with SC055 Yella Bout It, apply 3 coats to the front and sides of the canvas. Allow glaze to dry between coats.
3. Before the glaze is bone dry, lay the pattern over the canvas and trace with the pencil. You should be able to see the pattern in the glaze.
4. Using the Script Liner with SC074 Hot Tamale, apply 1 coat to the top/left flower, 2 coats to the top/right flower and 3 coats to the bottom flower. Allow glaze to dry between coats.
5. Using the Detail Liner with SC015 Tuxedo, outline the flowers and lettering.
6. Fire to cone 06.
